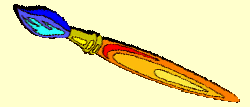


CHILDREN PAINT FOR PEACE 13TH INTERNATIONAL PAINTING COMPETITION



This year we are asking you to paint or draw a picture that expresses the theme "MAY PEACE PREVAIL ON EARTH". What comes to your mind when you read these words and how can you express your ideas on a piece of paper? Your artwork can portray an image of peace at home, at school, outside in nature or in your community. Be sure to include the words "May Peace Prevail on Earth," written in your native language, somewhere in the picture. We look forward to your entries! Please follow the guidelines below.

Age groups and awards:

There is a 1st, a 2nd and a 3rd place in each of the following age groups:

5 - 8 years 9 - 12 years 13 - 15 years 16 - 19 years

All winners will receive a colour pencil set & art supplies sponsored by Rotary Clubs of New York.

Guidelines:

- ☺ The theme is: "May Peace Prevail on Earth".
- ☺ Each entry must include the words „May Peace Prevail on Earth“ somewhere in the picture.
- ☺ The size of each design must be 17 x 12 cm, either horizontal or vertical.
The number of entries from each child is unlimited!
- ☺ The theme can be drawn or painted, but please do not use any organic or loose items..

☺ Important Information:

On the back of each picture submitted, please place an adhesive label with the following information (printed legibly): The year 2010, full name of artist, age, address, e-mail (if available), phone number and country. If school classes want to send entries, we need the name and the address of the school plus a teacher as contact person.

Deadline: July 31st 2010

Winners will be notified by email or postal mail soon after an Awards Ceremony in September 2010. The winning artwork will be featured on www.wppspeacepals.org. All participants can download and print their own certificate of participation. A link to the certificates will be e-mailed to you by December 31, 2010. If you have no internet access, please write on the back of your entry "no e-mail".

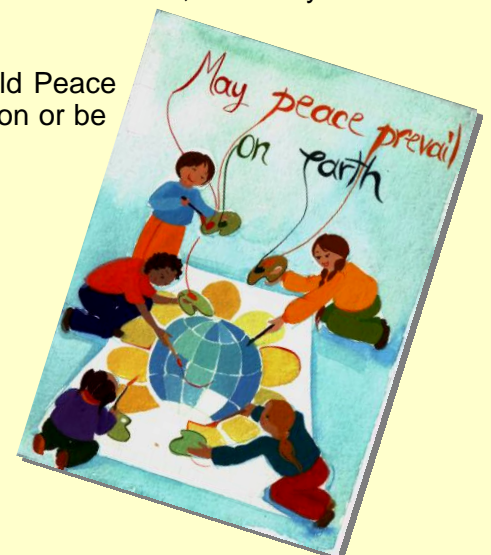
All artwork becomes the property of Peace Pals, a programme of the World Peace Prayer Society, and could become part of an international travelling exhibition or be used to print posters and cards
